NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Flying Phantom class, International A class catamaran (only foiling), International S9 class and single handed multihulls.
- 3.2. All boats have to comply with their Class Rules and have a valid measurement certificates.
- 3.3. All competitors shall be members of their National Class Association or the International Class Association where there is no appropriate national class association.
- 3.4. The helms person named on the boat entry form shall be the same for all races.
- 3.5. Eligible competitors shall enter by completing the online entry process at: <http://WWW.CIRCOLOVELAARCO.COM>
- 3.6. **Online entries will close on September 08th, 2020**



4. FEES

4.1 Early entry fee, paid before September 6th : single handed 150€. Late entry fee, paid on September , 6th - 8th : 180 €

Early entry fee, paid before September 6th : double handed 240€. Late entry fee, paid on September , 6th - 8th : 280 €

4.2. The entry fee must be paid by bank transfer (wire details will be sent during the online registration). Bank fees shall be paid by entrant. PayPal payment is available as well, Paypal commission is 5 € and it has to be paid by entrant.

4.3. Entry fees depend exclusively on the date by that payment is received.

5.1. The scheduled time of the first warning signal on September, 17th and 18th is at 1pm.

5.2. There will be no warning signal made after 4.30pm on September, 20th 2020.

6. MEASUREMENT

6.1. Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate for all equipment and sails at registration.

6.2. Equipment shall only be replaced with the permission of the Race Committee.

6.3. Boats may be subject to inspections at any time during the regatta.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on September 16th on the regatta website of the sailing club www.circolovelaarco.com

NO printed copy will be provided by the OA.

8. VENUE

The event will be held at Circolo Vela Arco in Arco.

9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10.2. Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

11. SCORING

11.1. The Low Point System of Appendix „A“ will apply.

a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

b) When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores

11.2. In the split fleet format, a minimum of 3 races for each fleet must be completed to constitute a series.

11.3. Six boats are requested to constitute a class.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered with the Organizing Authority and shall display always the yellow flag with the black "S", given by the Club.

13. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in the assigned places at the boat park.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15. PRIZES

15.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors for each class with at least 6 participants.

15.2. Additional prizes may be given at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

16. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

16.1. By participating in Foiling Week 2020, competitors automatically grant the Organizing Authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

16.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.

16.3. The top three (3) competitors, as well as the individual race winners, may be required to attend a media press conference each day.

16.4. Competitors may be required to be interviewed during the regatta.

17. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 4 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor and their responsible adult agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practicably provided in the circumstances

18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent.

19. CLEAN REGATTA

The regatta is run accordingly to Sailors for the Sea standards of a "clean regatta".

20. HOSPITALITY

20.1 Boats, trailers and cars will be hosted for free on the Yacht Club area from September, 14th to 21st 2020.

20.2 Campers are not allowed in the parking area of the Yacht Club (both during the day and the night).

20.3 The club area is open from 8.30 - 18h
