Admission

The Italian National Championship and the Moth Euro Cup are open to all boats of the International IMCA Class. All competitors shall be current members of their national class.

All the competitors shall present during the Registration

- o a supporting document to justify their membership to their National IMCA association.
- o a proof to be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1. 500.000

Only the Italian competitors shall present during the Registration

- o The Italian Federation Registration (FIV) Card and valid medical certificate or FIV Plus Derive Card

Advertising

In accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Advertising Code), boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

Registration

The pre-registrations will have to be sent to the Circolo Vela Arco through the form on the web site www.circolovelaarco.com with the payment (paypal) within 13th September 2019. Entry fee € 140,00.

For registrations after this date, the registration fee will be € 210.00.

The sailing instruction will be available at the registration on 20th September.

Scoring

Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be total of the race scores. When five (5) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When nine (9) to twelve (12) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores. The Italian National Champion title, awarded to the first Italian skipper FIV registered, will be awarded only if a minimum of 4 races will be completed.

Rules

The regatta are governed by:

- The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing - FIV regulation for the National Sports activities has to be considered "Rule"
- The IMCA Class Rules
- Racing rule(s) might change as follows:
Rule 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

Measurement

Boats shall provide a valid measurement certificate for all equipment and sails at registration; boats may be subject to inspection and measurement at any time during the regatta.

Only 2 masts, 2 front foils (vertical & horizontal) and 2 rear foils (vertical & horizontal) shall be used. Foils shall not be changed on the water; they shall only be changed when the boat is ashore.

Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after regatta. 14.5 Under 18's will also need to have filled in the parental consent form, available on event website

Prizes

Trophies will be awarded :

- National Italian Championship - Top 3 (Italian competitors - FIV Registered)
- Open Italian Championship – Top 3 Overall
- First Master (Over 45)
