NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

On behalf of Italian Sailing Federation (F.I.V.);
hosted and organized by Circolo Vela Arco A.s.d. (C.V.A.)
in conjunction with the Italian Nacra-9er Association (N-9er)

2. VENUE

The regatta will be held on the waterfront of Circolo Vela Arco.

3. RULES

- 3.1 The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS);
- 3.2 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures Rule 42, will apply;
- 3.3 The Class Rules will apply except for any amendment introduced by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instruction;
- 3.4 The Italian Nationals Authority prescriptions will apply;
- 3.5 If there is conflict between languages the English version will take precedence.

4. ADVERTISING

Advertising is permitted as per WS Regulation 20. Italian boats displaying advertisements must submit the appropriate license issued by the FIV. Competitor may be required from the organizing authority to display advertising stickers or/and flags on both sides of the hull during the whole event.

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the N-9er Class with a valid measurement certificate;
- 5.2 Competitors must be registered at their Class for the year 2020.
- 5.3 Pre-registrations shall be sent to Circolo Vela Arco using the form available on the web site www.circolovelaarco.com, together with the payment of the entry fee within Monday 13th April 2020.
- 5.4 Italian sailors shall show their FIV membership card 2020 with valid medical certificate. Foreign sailors shall carry a similar card issued by their national sailing authority.
- 5.5 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.500.000 per event or the equivalent if expressed in other currencies. The above documents shall be shown at registration no later than 10:30 AM of Friday 1st May 2020.

6. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is € 150,00 if pre-registration will be made through the web site www.circolovelaarco.com together with the payment within 13th April 2020. After that date the fee will be € 225,00.

- 7.2 The warning signal for the 1st race on Friday 1st May 2020 will be given at 12.00 PM.
7.3 The time of the warning signal for the 1st race on Saturday 2nd May 2020 will be given by a notice on the official notice board before 8.00 PM of the day before it will take effect.
7.4 On last racing day, no warning signal will be displayed after 4.00 PM.

8. MEASUREMENTS

A valid measurement certificate shall be shown to the organizing authority at registration.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at the race office during registrations.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1 The course of 49erFx and 49er will be - windward/leeward with a gate at the leeward end of the course;
10.2 The course of Nacra17 will be - windward/leeward with a spreader mark at the windward end and a gate at the leeward end of the course.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by a One-Turn penalty.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 A maximum of 9 (nine) races will be scheduled.
12.2 Every day a maximum of 3 races may be held. It will be possible to perform the 4^o race to resume a race which was not sailed the day before or, in case of adverse weather forecast, to anticipate a race scheduled for the next day.
12.3 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix 'A' will apply.
12.4
- When less than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the sum of all scores achieved in all races.
 - When 4 to 8 races will be completed, the boat's series score will be the sum of the scores achieved in all race scores excluding the worst one.
 - When 9 races will be completed the boat's series score will be the sum of the scores achieved in all the race scores excluding the two worst ones.
 - The event will be valid even with only one valid race.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 teams per class.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk or with the approval of an adult guardian where applicable (See RRS 4, Decision to Race).

Each competitor will be responsible for the decision of start or continue racing. The Organizing Committee, the Race Committee and the Jury will not accept any responsibility for any damage that might be caused to persons or property both in water and on the ground before, during and after the race.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000,00 per incident or the equivalent. The original document certifying that insurance shall be submitted at registration. It will have to be clear and in Italian or English language.

16. SUPPORT BOATS

Motorboats are prohibited to navigate on the northern part of Lake Garda.

However, during this event, a special permit to use such boats may be given (producing the required documents) by the Circolo Vela Arco if team leaders and coaches agree to the following rules:

- to be registered as a Coach in C.V.A. Office paying the Coach Fee before launching the rib;
- to indiscriminately provide technical or health assistance to the eventuality, contacting the RC if it is necessary to enter in the race area;
- maximum 2 people are allowed on the motorboat (legal age: 18 years);
- to follow all instructions given by the Race Committee underwriting the proper form by the Secretary Office of the Circolo Vela Arco.
- Each motorboat have to display the proper flag, provided by the Club. For the flag a deposit of € 20.00 will be required. It will be possible that you will be obliged to display also a sticker with an identification number.

The required documents that have to be sent to the race office (if possible before arriving) are:

- engine registration document of the rib (engine brand name - engine serial number);
- current insurance of the engine;
- driver's identity document or navigation license, if the engine is 40.8 HP or more.

ARRIVALS:

In order to speed up and simplify the arrivals we ask you
Not to offload the boats in the car park:

- 1 - Come to the office to register your arrival and to get the stickers to be applied on boats/road trailers/ribs/cars.
- 2 - Offload the boats in the area indicated by the staff.
- 3 - Apply the stickers before pulling the sailing boats inside the "Boats Park".
- 4 - Ask for directions to launch the motorboat.

OUR BASIC RULES:

Sailors have to take care of their own boats & equipment.

Boats have to be rigged on the given boat place.

The beach area is only for transit and hauling boats, you have always to keep the cycle path and the beach clear! Trolley have to be left on the TROLLEY AREA in front of the ramp, do not leave them on the beach or on the ramp! NEVER leave your boat alone on the beach, but keep it inside the given boat place, also during the lunch break. Respect, order and cleanliness are fundamental, but mostly important is your Fun.
