## 1. RULES

As provided for in Class Rule 22, Appendix P5, Flags O and R apply for this regatta. Appendix T, Arbitration, applies for this regatta.

## 3. REGATTA OFFICE & FLAG POLE LOCATION

The Regatta Office is by the secretary office of the club and the flagpole is located close to the changing rooms and to the boat's park..

## 4. CLASS FLAG

**Class flags will be flags with colors of fleet.**

## 5. COURSES

All courses are TW3 **with a gate as mark 3**. If one of the gates marks are not laid, the laid mark must be left to port.

## 6. MARKS

**Start Marks:** Race Committee Vessels with a staff flying an orange flag

**Marks 1, 2 & 3:** Orange inflatable buoys

**Finish Mark:** Orange mark hosting a stick flying an orange flag

**New Mark for change of the course:** White inflatable buoy

## 7. TIME LIMITS

Target Time: 45 minutes

Race Time Limit: 100 minutes

Finishing Window: 20 minutes

## **8. SUBSTITUTION OF COMPETITORS AND EQUIPMENT**

Substitution of competitors will not be allowed.

Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the Race Committee or allowed by the class rules. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race Committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

## **9. LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
