



2021 OK Dinghy Internationals

Arco, Italy, 12-15 July

NOTICE OF RACE

“The regatta activities must be CARRIED OUT in accordance with the provisions on CONTACT and containment AGAINST the SPREAD of COVID-19 issued by the Federation, WHICH the Organising Committees will activate and to which the EVERYONE INVOLVED IN THE EVENT must comply WITH under the supervision of the Organising Committee itself. Any cases of COVID-19 that should be detected during the event will be reported by the Organising Committee to the competent health bodies in charge”

1. Organising Authority and Venue

- 1.1 The 2021 OK Dinghy Internationals will be held from **12 July to 15 July**, 2021 in Arco, Italy.
- 1.2 The Organising Authority is Circolo Vela Arco.

2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and this Notice of Race. These may be changed, where permitted, by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 No national prescriptions shall apply.
- 2.3 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 2.4 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. Such advertising, if any, shall be displayed in accordance with the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.5 All competitors will be required to wear an adequate personal floatation device at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. (This changes RRS 40.)
- 2.6 Coach boat restrictions may be applied. These will be published in or with the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.7 All competitors, coaches and accompanying persons shall at all times abide by the COVID-19 regulations as stipulated by Circolo Vela Arco.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 **The Entry Fee is €220** and will be made online by PayPal or credit card on the website of the sailing club <http://www.circolovelaarco.it/regate-lago-di-garda-2021>
Entries can be made only through this website, accompanied by the required entry fees and entry forms. These must be received by the Organising Authority by June 30th 2021.
Late entries may be accepted by the Organising Authority until July 4th, but **the Late Entry Fee will be €330.**
Coaches have to register their motorboats by email to race-office@circolovelaarco.com (they need to send a copy of the valid insurance, police, engine documents and ID card or navigation licence if the engine is more than 40.8 HP) and receive a special permit and a yellow S flag. Entry fee €50.00. Deposit for flag €20.00
- 3.5 Refunds for cancellations or failure to attend will not be made unless decided otherwise by the Organising Authority.
- 3.6 Valid measurement certificates shall be presented, or their existence verified, at on-site registration in accordance with RRS 78.2.

4. Competition Format

- 4.1 Ten races are scheduled.



5. Event Schedule

- 5.1 The event schedule may be changed and will be specified in the Sailing Instructions, however, the days allocated for racing will not be changed.

6. Schedule of Races

- 6.1 Two or three races are scheduled for each day of racing.
6.2 Succeeding races will be started as soon as practicable after the finish of the previous race.
6.3 No warning signal will be made after 4pm on Thursday 15 July 2021.

7. Sailing Instructions

- 7.1 The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at the club on July, 9th. A preliminary version may be posted on the club website prior to this date.

8. Racing Area

- 8.1 The intended race course area will be Lake Garda - north - Trentino.

9. Courses

- 9.1 Courses will be either as specified in the Sailing Instructions.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 10 competitors. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

11. Media Consent: Rights to use Names & Likenesses

Competitors and / or their Guardians automatically grant the Organising Authority, OKDIA and any party to which they may delegate this right, without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show (including via the internet), any motion pictures, still pictures, live, taped or filmed television, or any other form of media, of or relating to the event.

12. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority will require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or properties occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the Yacht Club premises. The Organising Authority, and their respective members, employees, officers and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.
